## **Regulations for the 25th Anniversary NBG Tournament by ANSGP**

These regulations establish the tournament's structure, participation rules, game format, and the rules to be applied during the commemorative tournament marking the 25th Anniversary of Nevada Bobs Golf, organised in association with the Portuguese National Senior Golf Association (ANSGP).

### **1. Definition of the Competition**

1.1. The 25th Anniversary NBG Tournament by ANSGP is a one-off event commemorating the 25th anniversary of Nevada Bobs Golf. It is organised by ANSGP, promoted through the Association's usual communication channels, and marks a new milestone in the partnership between NBG and the ANSGP.

1.2. Registrations must be made exclusively via the website [www.apsgolfe.pt](http://www.apsgolfe.pt) or by email sent to the ANSGP.

### **2. Participation**

2.1. The 25th Anniversary NBG Tournament by ANSGP is open to all players with a valid Handicap and an active license issued by the Portuguese Golf Federation (FPG).

2.2. Participation is limited to a maximum of 96 players.

2.3. As the tournament organiser, the ANSGP reserves 48 spots for its members.

2.4. The playing handicap is limited to 36. Players with a higher handicap may participate, but their playing handicap will be adjusted to 36.

### **3. Game Format**

3.1. The 25th Anniversary NBG Tournament by ANSGP will be played over one round of 18 holes.

3.2. The competition format is Stableford Nett, played with 100% of the player's handicap.

3.3. A player must discontinue playing a hole once their score no longer results in scoring points on that hole.

### **3.4. Tee Marker Positions**

#### **3.4.1. Men (Mid-Amateur, Senior, and Super Senior categories):**

Yellow tees, or their equivalent.

#### **3.4.2. Men (Master Senior category):**

Red tees, or their equivalent. Should a player wish to play from the yellow tees (or equivalent), this must be indicated at the time of registration, and their playing handicap will be adjusted accordingly. Playing from the Yellow tees will result in their being classified under the Super Senior category for ranking purposes.

#### **3.4.3. Ladies:**

Red tees, or equivalent.

### **4. Rankings and Prizes**

#### **4.1. The tournament will include the following ranking categories:**

- Overall Stableford Nett
- Stableford Nett – Ladies
- Stableford Gross – Mid-Amateur, Senior, and Super Senior
- Stableford Gross – Master Seniors
- Stableford Gross – Ladies

#### **4.2. Criteria for ties – For all ranking categories, the following criteria will be applied, and in this order:**

- Best score on the last hole
- Best score over the last 3 holes
- Best score over the last 6 holes
- Best score over the last 9 holes
- Lowest handicap

#### **4.3. Prizes will be awarded to the following:**

- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place – Overall Stableford Nett
- 1st place – Stableford Nett Ladies
- 1st place – Stableford Gross Mid-Amateur, Seniors, and Super Seniors

- 1st place – Stableford Gross Master Seniors
- 1st place – Stableford Gross Ladies

## **5. Rules**

5.1. All official ANSGP golf competitions are governed by:

- The Rules of Golf issued by R&A Rules Limited,
- The FPG Handicap System Rules,
- The Local Rules of the Course,
- The Permanent Local Rules of the Portuguese National Senior Golf Association (ANSGP).

5.2. The golf course where the competition takes place must be officially approved and certified by the FPG.

## **6. Additional Provisions**

- 6.1. The draw will be conducted using the serpentine method and in ascending order of handicap. However, the Tournament Director may make specific adjustments if deemed necessary.
- 6.2. Withdrawals or no-shows will be handled in accordance with the applicable regulations published on this matter.
- 6.3. At any time, the ANSGP Board or the Technical Committee appointed to oversee the competition may amend these regulations, as well as suspend, postpone, or cancel the event. Their decisions are final in all matters not expressly covered in this document.
- 6.4. These regulations were approved by the ANSGP Board and enter into force as of September 2025.
