Rankings Regulation RACE to ESGA

This regulation establishes the participation rules and the points tables to be used in the preparation of the RACE to ESGA Rankings of the National Association of Senior Golfers – Portugal (ANS GP).

1. Definitions

1.1. The RACE to ESGA Rankings are the National ANSGP rankings that will be used from 2026 onwards to select the players who will represent the ANSGP in official national and international competitions.

1.2. These Rankings are also used to determine which players are selected for the qualifying phase of ESGA 2027.

2. Participation

2.1. The RACE to ESGA Rankings are open exclusively to ANSGP members with up-to-date fees and a valid FPG license.

2.2. Players are divided into 4 categories:

2.2.1. **Seniors** – Players who will have completed between 50 and 64 years of age before January 1, 2027.

2.2.2. **Super Seniors** – Players who will have completed between 65 and 74 years of age before January 1, 2027.

2.2.3. **Master Seniors** – Players who have turned 75 before January 1, 2027.



2.2.4. **Ladies** – Female players who have turned 50 before January 1, 2027

3. **8 Rankings RACE to ESGA are created**

3.1. São criadas 8 Rankings RACE to ESGA

- RACE to ESGA - Seniors Gross
- RACE to ESGA - Seniors Nett
- RACE to ESGA - Super Seniors Gross
- RACE to ESGA - Super Seniors Nett
- RACE to ESGA - Master Seniors Gross
- RACE to ESGA - Master Seniors Nett
- RACE to ESGA - Ladies Gross
- RACE to ESGA - Ladies Nett

3.2. All regular tournaments of each of the 3 Regional Golf Circuits – North, Centre, and South – and the regular tournaments of the National Order of Merit are eligible for the RACE to ESGA Rankings.

3.3. The tournaments are divided by National O.M. and Regional Circuits. The attached tables reflect the points to be awarded for each position in the standings, by type of tournament and the number of eligible players present in each tournament..

3.4. The score points for the RACE to ESGA Gross Rankings are awarded according to the final Stableford Gross classification achieved in each tournament, according to the points table corresponding to the Tournament Type and the number of participants in the category..

3.5. Scoring points for the Race to ESGA Nett Rankings are awarded according to the final Stableford Nett classification obtained in each tournament, based on the points table corresponding to the Tournament Type and the number of participants in the Category.

3.6. For each of the Rankings, the **8 (Eight) best results** obtained throughout the year are counted.

4. **Supplementary Provisions**



4.1. At any time, the Board or the Technical Committee appointed by it to oversee the competition may amend these Regulations and suspend, postpone, or cancel the competition, making final decisions on any omitted cases.

4.2. This regulation was approved by the board and comes into effect from January 2026, applying to the entire 2026 season and beyond.
